- Lead this quick cognitive warm up to build attention, processing speed, nimbleness and other cognitive skills, as well as group connection.
- Ask the class to create a short story. Have each student add a sentence to the story that begins with the next letter of the alphabet. Continue until you get to Z or when time runs out.
- Have everyone clap or snap fingers to set a good pace.
- When repeating this class, use a new prompt.
- Encourage distance learners to join in from home.
